

Code of Conduct

The Offices of Catholic Schools, Religious Education and Youth Ministry provide opportunities that allow young people from all over the Diocese of Owensboro to be educated, grow in their faith, have fun and form Christian friendships. All that we do stems from our belief in Jesus Christ and the following of his teachings. Therefore, we have certain expectations of the children, youth and adults who participate. To insure a safe and enjoyable time for everyone, the following guidelines are in effect. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to explain this Code of Conduct to their child.

Students in grades K – 3 read and sign below. By doing so you understand that any action inconsistent with this Code of Conduct may result in appropriate disciplinary action.

- I will be kind and say nice things to others.
- I will keep my hands to myself except when helping others.
- I will take turns and include others in games.
- I will tell when someone is being hurt or there is an emergency.
- I will respect other's property and private space.
- I will be a good listener and not interrupt.
- I will obey school/parish rules and respect the adults who watch over me.
